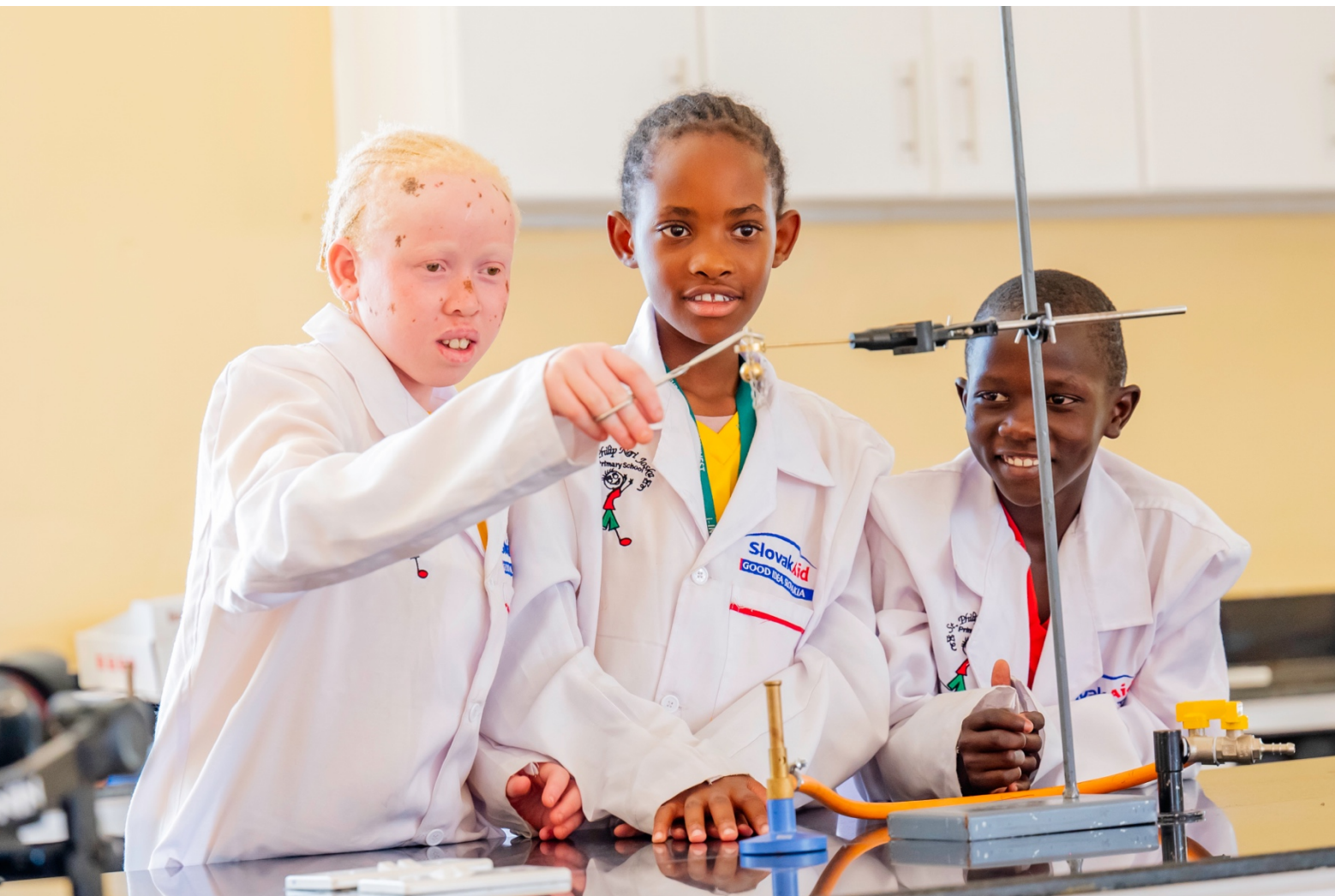

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Fee is payable in full on or before 1st day of every term.
2. Advance fee payment (full fees paid before opening of a term) will attract a 5% discount on tuition fee.
3. FAMILY DISCOUNTS on tuition fees only are allowed in bills as follows:
 - 2nd child: 5%
 - 3rd child: 10%
 - 4th child: 20%
 - 5th & subsequent child: 25%
 - Subject to full fee payment at that particular term. T&Cs apply.
4. Caution fee is refundable less deductions due to loss or damaged school property.
5. One term notice of the intention to withdraw a child should be submitted in writing and the headteacher's acknowledgement in writing of the same is required, failure to which FULL TERM'S FEE IS PAYABLE in lieu of such notice.
6. Weekly boarding available on request. However, the school treats boarding fee as one unit.
7. All PAID UP/SIGNED UP activities are billed and treated separately from the fees.
8. All fee is payable through the designate Bank accounts or M-Pesa Paybill Wallet.

The management reserves the right to review the fees from time to time in accordance with prevailing conditions.

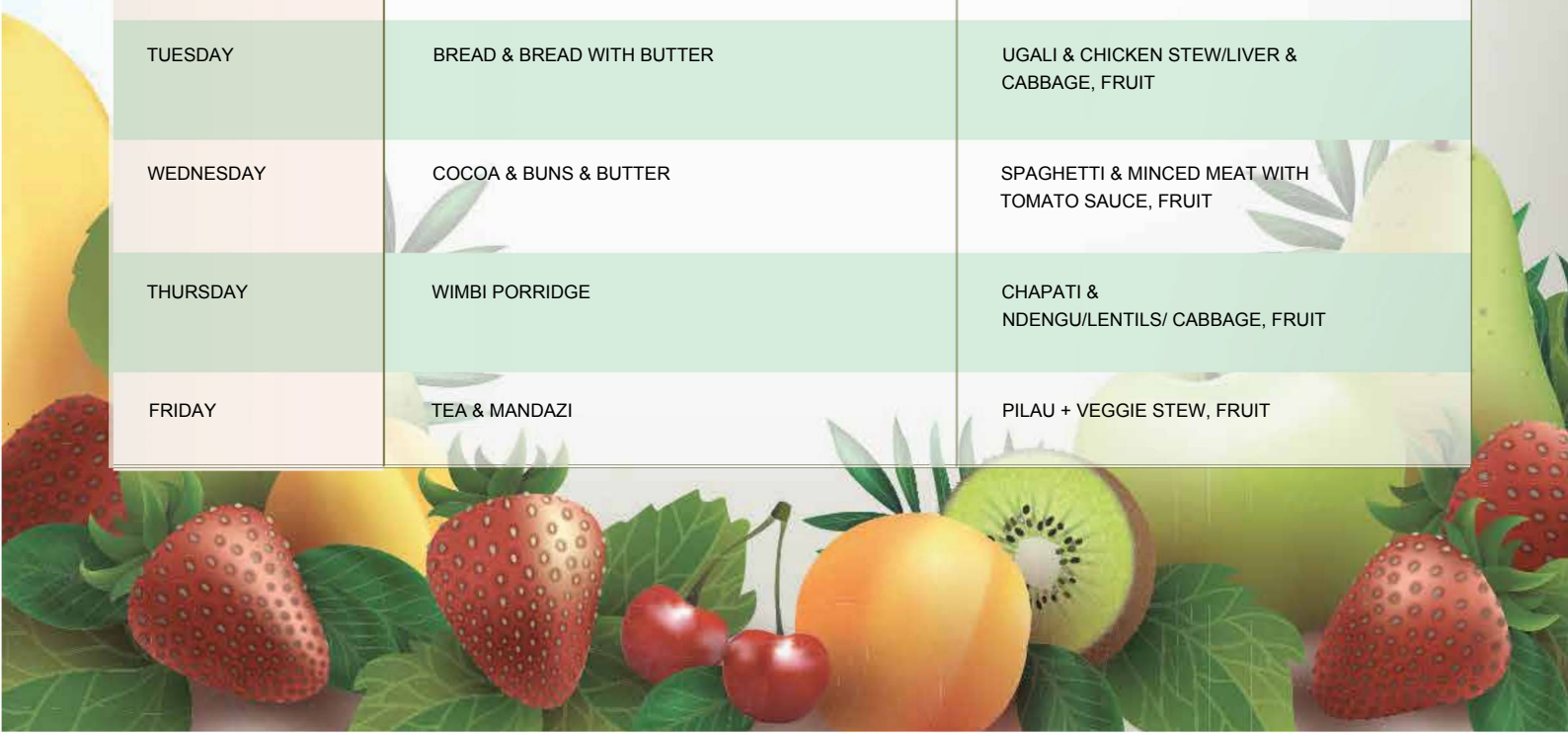
