A Message From The Directors

As we, the Directors, reflect on the past decade, we are overwhelmed with a shared sense of pride and gratitude for the remarkable progress St. Philip Neri School has made. Our collective journey has been characterized by significant growth in infrastructure, the pioneering of innovative programs, and a steadfast dedication to preparing our students for a globalized world. Our shared vision has always been to place our school at the pinnacle of educational excellence, and we are proud to elaborate on the key pillars of this transformative period.

INFRASTRUCTURE HIGHLIGHTS: BUILDING A FOUNDATION FOR MODERN LEARNING

Our commitment to holistic development is perhaps most visible in our newly built sports complex. This facility boasts a semi-Olympic swimming pool, basketball and volleyball courts, and an astro-turf football pitch. These are not just venues for play; they are essential tools for fostering discipline, teamwork, and athletic excellence. We have already begun forging strategic partnerships with European football junior leagues and national county swimming federations, with the clear goal of elevating our students' training to meet international standards.

INNOVATIVE PROGRAMS: NURTURING GLOBAL CITIZENS AND ARTISTS

Our academic and co-curricular programs continue to set us apart. Our Chess Club has gained impressive national and international recognition, with our learners competing at the highest levels in countries like Egypt and Italy over the past two years, sharpening their critical thinking and strategic planning. Similarly, our participation in the World Scholars Program has prepared our students to compete among elite schools globally. We have seen twelve learners compete in Malaysia, and seven are preparing to showcase their talents in the USA, gaining invaluable confidence and global exposure.

As directors, our hearts are deeply filled with a passion for music, and we are committed to fostering this art throughout our school. This dedication was profoundly reflected in 2024 when our school choir achieved a remarkable milestone by emerging as gold winners at the national music festivals. Our kindergarten choir has also been shining comfortably within the Embakasi cluster. Beyond vocal excellence, we place great emphasis on instrumental music, nurturing talent with instruments like the violin, piano, drums, and flute under the guidance of professional musicians. This training not only produces beautiful music but also prepares students for prestigious international ABRSM examinations.

We firmly believe that music and drama are inseparable in nurturing well-rounded children. Drama instils confidence, effective communication, and collaborative skills. We are incredibly proud that our school is co-producing the upcoming local TV show, "Born to Shine Reborn," which will showcase our students' dramatic and musical talents. This project is a movement to inspire the public to believe in and support the dreams of every child.

LOOKING AHEAD: A FUTURE OF SUSTAINABLE GROWTH AND EXCELLENCE

Our future initiatives are designed to further enhance our students' development and our operational sustainability. We are excited to announce the establishment of the **Neri Stallions FC**, a football club committed to nurturing future professionals under experienced coaches. Alongside this, the **Neri Little Dolphins Swim Club** will be an elite program designed to foster exceptional swimming talent.

Our new CBC Centre and Sustainable Agriculture project, located just 600 meters from the school, will be a hands-on learning hub for agripreneurship. It will feature two large greenhouses, a rabbit house for 50 rabbits, a chicken coop for 1,000 chickens, and facilities for 30 goats and 20 guinea pigs, promoting food security and eco-conscious entrepreneurship.

Furthermore, our Green Initiatives remain a cornerstone of our vision. We have already achieved 60% adoption of renewable energy through solar power and are determined to reach 100% by 2027. In collaboration with local authorities, we are also engaged in a large-scale tree-planting initiative, aiming to plant over 3,000 trees by the end of 2026 to enhance biodiversity and environmental awareness.

A Landmark Celebration: The Grand Launch of the St. Philip Neri Sports Complex

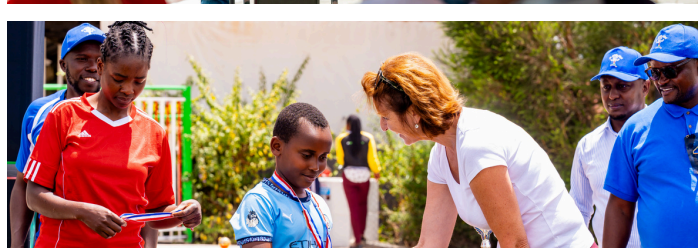

Field Trips: Educational Adventures



Coastal Circuit, Naivasha and Beyond



GRADE 9 TRIP ALONG THE COASTAL CIRCUIT

Our Grade 9 students embarked on an unforgettable four-day educational trip to Mombasa, traveling aboard the Standard Gauge Railway and staying at the scenic Plaza Beach Hotel in Bamburi. Neri Stallions FC
